FNN Hurricane Coverage General Policies

When *"Hurricane Warnings" are posted along any portion of the Florida peninsula by order of the National Hurricane Center and evacuations are ordered, FNN may initiate its hurricane coverage program schedule. The decision to begin this coverage will depend upon the anticipated impact of the storm upon Florida communities. FNN news affiliates wishing to air coverage of the hurricane may take any or all of the following:

- 2:30 minute reports at :20 past each hour 24 hours a day as long as the
 "Warnings" are in effect. These reports may include a :30 commercial. The XDS
 program "FNN Special Report (L or R)" should be scheduled to Port A of your
 receiver. Audio will appear on either the left or right channel in mono. Net Cue
 "FNN0101" will be sent to start the event, "FNN0103" will be sent to end the
 event.
- Regular FNN newscasts from 6:30AM through 6:30PM (Eastern). The hurricane and hurricane-related news events will always be the lead story and will more-thanlikely occupy most of the first 2 minutes of the newscasts.

Note: When hurricane warnings are issued FNN will send an advisory to all stations via Twitter account @NewsFNN. Please follow this Twitter feed for urgent advisories
